PÄRLÄLVEN



The Pearl River is one of the last unregulated rivers in Jokkmokk. The total length of Jokkmokk Hunting and Fishing Association fishing areas along the Pearl River is about 50 kilometers, (including lakes etc.). One area of the river is exclusively reserved for fly fishing only (Zone 4 at the map).

Along the river is several fireplaces and wind shelter located that can be used for free by visitors in the area.

To adapt the recreational fishing due to the Pearl Rivers natural conditions, regulation of the fishing is necessary. Therefore is the river divided up in several different fishing zones, with different zone specific fishing rules. There are also general fishing rules for the whole fishing area in the river, with limitation in amount and size of the catch. Earlier tests have shown that the quality of the recreational fishing in the river, therefore has been greatly improved.

Fishing rules for Pärälven (Pearl River) Appokätno (Appok River) and Purkiforsen (Purki Rapids).

- Fishing prohibited from 15th of September until 15th of June every year.
- Maximum 3 salmonid fishes (Grayling, Brown Trout) per person and fishing day may be taken. In Pärälven (Pearl River) and Appokälven (Appok River) is it only allowed to take maximum one Trout (included in the total limitation of maximum three salmonid fishes).
- Minimum length 30 centimeters. Maximum length 40cm for salmonid fishes.
- In the fly fishing area (Zone 4) is only fishing with fly fishing rod allowed.
- Boat fishing prohibited. Belly Boat allowed

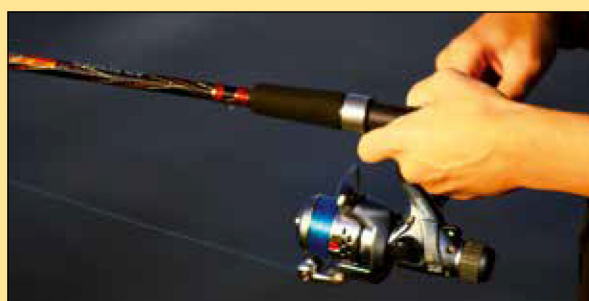
